

HISTORY

Most written evidence agrees that winegrowing in this area dates back to the 2nd century BC.

Production reached its peak around the middle of the 19th century, when the vineyards spread over some 6,000 hectares.

But around 1870, the phylloxera crisis wiped out up to 80% of plantings and only 1,000 hectares remained.

In 1910, the area received its first distinction - an appellation d'origine encompassing 41 local villages.
